Year 4 Play

We would like the boys in Year 4 to return to school at 5.45pm on Wednesday, 17th May and Friday, 19th May so that they will have plenty of time to get into their costumes and have their make-up done ready for the play. **PLEASE DO NOT BE LATE.** Refreshments will be provided for parents in the Main School Dining Room from 6.15pm.

All boys need to return to school in uniform, having had a quiet time at home and something to eat. We suggest they do not take part in any extra after school activities, as it will be a very tiring few days and the boys have worked incredibly hard during rehearsals. **There will be no Year 4 Swimming after school on Wednesday, 17th May and no Sailing or Cookery Club on Friday, 19th May.** On Thursday, matches will go ahead as usual. If you are not coming to the performance, please collect your son at approximately 8.20pm from the Junior School building. (Photo shoots and curtain calls permitting!)

The boys will be wearing make-up for the performances. The brand used is hypoallergenic but please let your teacher know as soon as possible if you have any concerns about this. If in doubt, we would rather not use make-up on your son.

Mrs. Brownsdon has agreed that the Year 4 boys can have a later start after the first performance and may come to school at 10.20am on Thursday, 18th May. If this causes any difficulties for working parents, please be assured that the teachers will be in school at the normal time. It will be a relaxed start to the day. Contact the relevant form teacher directly if your son will be arriving at the usual time.

Please note that the performance will be recorded on Wednesday, 17th May. In line with school policy, recording devices should not be used during either performance. Photographs will be available on the website shortly after the production.

May we take this opportunity to say thank you for all your encouragement in helping the boys to learn their lines and song words. We look forward to two wonderful performances and to seeing you on the night. Seating plans will be displayed at the entrance to the theatre on performance nights.
