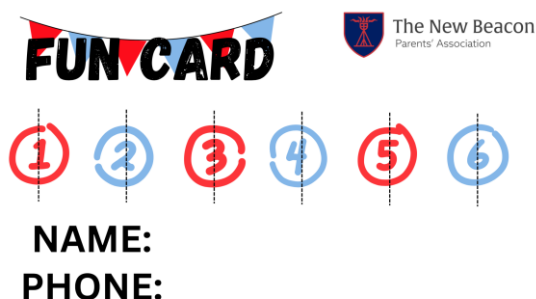

Dear School Community,

We are delighted to officially roll out New Beacon Parents' Association Fun Cards as the new way to pay at all NBPA events. This was trialled with much success at the Christmas Fayre and we are delighted with the way in which it streamlines our accounting as well as simplifying things for New Beacon families and children.

### What is a Fun Card?



A fun card can be purchased via [this link](#) for £5. It consists of 6 tokens which represent a value of £6, that can be used at stalls to pay at NBPA events. When paying, the stall volunteer will strike off the tokens using a pen. Stalls will be selling in multiples of 50p.

### Can I pay in cash if I run out of pre purchased Fun Cards?

There will be NO CASH at NBPA events going forward. At some stalls at the Summer fete - for example the Long Bar, the raffle, or external vendors - you will be able to tap to pay, and there will be Fun Cards available for purchase via Sum Up machines at the NBPA stall.

### What if I don't use all the card?

The Fun Cards will be used at all NBPA events where there would originally have been cash, so if you don't use it all at the event this time, you can use it next time! Just keep it safe.

**What if I lose my Fun Card?**

Experience has taught us that people do lose money at events; where we can reunite money with families, we do. Please write your name and a contact phone number on the Fun Card and we will make sure it gets returned!

**Can I buy Fun Cards on the day?**

At the Summer fete you will be able to buy Fun Cards at the NBPA stall. We strongly encourage you to pre-buy your cards however to eliminate as much queuing time as possible! You can use the Fun Cards at all events going forward, so they won't be wasted.
